Hostile Body Language	SMILE
Restricting Entire Class	Generic Good Behavior Game
Failing to Forgive	Restorative Circles, Restorative Conferences
Personalizing student Behavior	Affective Statements
Exempting yourself from the rules	Doing things "WITH"
Making too many rules	Teach/Model/Reinforce expectations

Restricting recess as a punishment
